Southeast Missouri Dance Competition November 8th, 2008

Farmington Knightline will be hosting the FIRST annual Southeast Missouri Dance Competition. The contest is open to all high and junior high school pompon/ dance drill teams and show teams from Missouri. AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded in each category. The number of trophies will be determined by the number of teams entered in that group. All teams are allowed a maximum of three routines. Divisions will be determined by the size of the school.

REGISTRATION

Registration is \$50.00 per routine that your team enters. **Solos and ensembles, \$35.00 each performance. Please limit your girls to only two extra performances. When girls perform in more than two of these performances, scheduling becomes very difficult.** Please register as soon as possible so that we will have some idea as to how many teams and routines we will have. This is necessary in order for us to arrange for qualified judges, trophies, etc. If you need to change categories or drop, it must be done no later than October 31st, 2008. **No refunds will be given after this date.** To cancel a performance, call Jymie Lilley at 573-701-1345 or email jlilley@farmington.k12.mo.us Indicate the name of the school team, and category to be canceled.

CATEGORIES

The following categories are available for entry: **KICK, POM PON, NOVELTY, DANCE/JAZZ, MIX, PROP, HIP HOP**. Category division will be made by school size. **There will also be a SOLO and ENSEMBLE Competition. Please note the separate registration form for these performances.**

Kick - Your routine should be choreographed to show your team's ability to high kick. Emphasis should be placed on kick control, uniformity of high kicks, kick timing, toe points and team stamina. Must contain a MINIMUM of 50 team performed kicks.

Pom Pon - Your routine should be performed with a strong visible use of the pompons throughout the routine. Only poms may be used in this category. Routine should not be a pom/kick combination. You must use poms at least 80% of the time.

Dance/Jazz -

Precision Jazz - This style allows your team to perform a routine with sharp, clean motions and to display effective formation changes. Concentration should be on precision rather than on technical elements

Lyrical Jazz – This style allows your team to perform a dance routine which incorporates the elements of dance technique. Concentration should be on the technical part rather than on the precision/formation part of the routine.

Mix – Your routine must be a mixture of these three dance styles: Dance, Pom and High Kick. There needs to be a minimum of 12 kicks.

Novelty – Your routine MUST have a theme and that theme must be carried out in the costume, music and dance style/moves. These are required. If used, NO MORE than 3 props are allowed.

Prop – Prop routines should use a MAXIMUM of 3 different props and may not use a backdrop. You must have at least 1 prop. Theme and costume not required. Emphasis should be use of props.

Hip Hop – This is NOT a Jazz Category. NO PROPS other than costume may be used. The routine must display the latest nontraditional dance styles (street dance, funk, popping). The routine must emphasize rhythm, execution, synchronization.

ADDITIONAL CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All participants on the gym floor during your performance must be regular participating members of your team. All members should have been eligible to perform all routines and must be enrolled as a full time student. Rules and regulations set forth by MSHSAA will be followed.
2. Routines will be evaluated on a point system. They may be a minimum of 2 minutes with a maximum of 2 1/2 minutes.
3. Music must be on a CD of “good” quality. You must also have a back-up CD. Your music must be the only track on the CD. Please label your music and deliver to the music table at least 30 minutes prior to your performance time.
4. Someone with sufficient knowledge of your music and routine should remain at the music table through the duration of your team’s performance. This person should also have your back-up CD in case of problems.
5. The performance area is a regulation size basketball court. The guaranteed lines on the court are the normal basketball court markings. Please be sure to have your team look at the court upon arrival to familiarize them with the area.
6. Judging will be from one side only and the routine should be performed to that side.
7. If you use props, you must make certain that all props are taped or padded and will not damage the floor. No props may be slammed or thrown down causing damage to the floor’s finish. Props that float to the ceiling and damage lights may not be released.
Teams will be charged for any damage by props. No fires are allowed.
8. Only soft soled shoes are allowed. No boots. No bare feet or half shoes.
9. Only battery video recording is allowed.
10. Each team will receive an audio cassette of the judge’s critiques.
11. Team members, directors and bus drivers will be admitted free. There will be a \$5.00 admission fee for all others. Please inform your parents and other spectators.
